Defence – Play of Second Hand – March 4 with Malcolm Coutts
“Second hand plays low” is a useful adage. However, you need to recognize the exceptions to the rule.

Defence – Playing the Odds – March 18 with Malcolm Coutts
By applying a few simple facts about percentages, you can improve your declarer play. This definitely not higher math.

Introduction to Squeeze Plays – April 29 with Tom Ramsay
Squeezes are the most advanced part of bridge play, but even beginners have executed squeezes, often by accident, if not by design. This workshop will teach the fundamentals of the squeeze play and demonstrate how to prepare and execute basic squeezes.

Discards – May 13 with Tom Ramsay
Discarding declarer is running a long suit. What do you discard that won’t cost your side a trick? This lesson will help your defence substantially.
