Two Flights: A/X/Y (2000+ / 1000-2000 / 0-1000) and B/C/D (300-500 / 100-300 / 0-100)

Stratification is determined by the average of the pair or team.

No player with more than 500 masterpoints can play in the B/C/D flight. All stratifications depend on depth of field. The director may adjust as required.

We will not be providing a lunch option but will have a longer lunch break so that people can make their own arrangements at local restaurants.
